#### ABOUT IEEE...

#### PURPOSE, AIM, GOALS

Welcome to our first issue of this new Supplement to the IEEE Publications Bulletin.

The Special Libraries Association Conference last June gave us a unique opportunity to meet many special, college and university library representatives in person. We would like to thank those of you who completed the questionnaire at the Conference, or have since then returned it to us. Your feedback, continued suggestions, and recommendations concerning IEEE products and services are appreciated and taken into consideration.

LIBRARY INFORMATION UPDATE will supplement the Publications Bulletin and focus on issues important to the library/information community. It is designed primarily to serve as a guide to the cataloging of IEEE conferences, and cataloging related information.

#### SERIALS CATALOGING

The vast majority of IEEE conference publications qualify for serials cataloging. Frequent title variations have occasionally interrupted serials cataloging and introduced monographic entries. Many have subsequently undergone recataloging at the Library of Congress and new main entries have been established, some replete with conference title changes and corresponding dates. IEEE and LC have joined efforts to solve IEEE conference cataloging problems. Procedures are also being implemented that assure consistency in conference titling and the referral of problems to LC for recataloging.

Starting in 1980, serials cataloging will also appear in the publication on the verso of the title page; plans to participate in CIP follow.

#### PREASSIGNED LCs

The IEEE Publications Bulletin will bring all preassigned LC numbers to your attention. The standard availability of LC cards for pre-assigned numbers is approximately six months after publication date. You will be notified of any changes in the status of these, preassigned numbers (cancellations, re-cataloging, etc.) in this section or by LC directly. All 1980 publications will bear the pre-assigned designation.

#### **IEEE CONFERENCE NEWS**

Important new information concerning IEEE-sponsored and cosponsored conferences will be included in this section. The type of news that will be covered includes conference title changes, series information, important shifts in conferences' emphases, and information that will make the perspective on conferences clearer to library and information personnel.

The IEEE Conference on Decision & Control including the Symposium on Adaptive Processes began as an expansion of the latter. Until last year, only the Symposium on Adaptive Processes received serial identification on the title page. The conference organizing committee has decided to include Decision & Control in the numbering of the Conference beginning with the 17th Symposium, held in January 1979. The title page of this volume, unfortunately, retained the previous years' format so that only through searching the introductory pages is this new numbering noted. The title page of the latest Conference Record, held in December 1979, appropiately reflects the inclusion of serial numbering for Decision & Control, along with an acknowledgement of the change in the forward or introduction and will be published as 18th IEEE CON-FERENCE ON DECISION & CONTROL including the SYM-POSIUM ON ADAPTIVE PROCESSES. This change will not affect the cataloging of the Conference.
