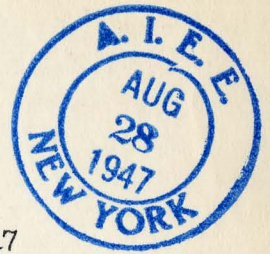

I regret to inform you that Dr. Wickenden suffered a severe heart attack last Wednesday at his summer home in Jaffrey, N.H. and is still in a very critical condition. He must remain in the hospital for three or four weeks after which he must have complete rest for at least six months. For this reason all his appointments must necessarily be cancelled.
