- Some Possible Principles: (1) Organized to best facilitate serving the technical interests of largest number of members.
 - (2) Give an official path for any interested member to try to influence the national technical thinking of his specialty.
 - (3) Provide only sufficient centralization to do such things as: (1) insure desirable uniformity of TPs; (2) minimize overlapping scopes; (3) determine desirable overall common operating practices; (4) establish outside technical representation, etc.
 - (4) Delegate as much authority as practiceable to operating technical units.
 - (5) In the coordinated technical structure deliberately provide for uniform IEEE Transactions of high quality covering each technical specialty that will constitute the permanent reference literature of the world.
 - (6) Group PGs and Technical Committees having a community of interests into Divisions for (a) operating coordination and (b) possibly published periodicals.
