The Second International Conference on Live-Line Maintenance ESMO-80 (80CH1612-1), held September 23-25, 1980, was listed in the January 1981 issue of the Bulletin. The first meeting in this series was held in Montreal, Canada on October 5-7, 1977. A record was published, but it was mainly distributed to conference attendees and was not sold though IEEE, even though it was assigned an IEEE publication number.
