Dear Dr. Houston:

I have your letter of the fifth instant in regard to the paper by you and Professor Coggeshall.

There is only one more meeting of the Institute during the present administrative year, i.e., the annual convention to be held in Boston, June 24-28 and the complete program for this meeting has already been approved and is now in press. I am therefore directed by the Chairman of the Meetings and Papers Committee to advise you that if you will forward your paper to this office when completed, it will be referred to the new Meetings & Papers Committee for the administrative year commencing August 1, 1912, which will be appointed by President-elect Mershon immediately after he takes office on August 1st.
