Dear Mr. Anderson:

Several questions are arising in connection with the accomplishment of transfers around January 1. It is realized that these undoubtedly cannot be answered at this time, but when the answers are known, I would appreciate some comments or being referred to the proper individuals for information that can be passed on to our Committee.

Because action by the Board of Examiners and the Board of Directors is required after the applications are in order, it is being suggested that Fellow proposals arrive at Headquarters complete by November 1 at the latest, or October 1, if there is any question about information not being complete. It is assumed that transfers to the Member Grade could possibly arrive later, if the references reply promptly?

It is assumed the transfer fees will be assessed for all transfers in grade that are approved before January 1. If the transfer in grade should be approved shortly before January 1 and a bill for the transfer fee sent to the individual, we assume he would become the appropriate new member class in A.I.E.E. if he remitted the fee before January 1. If not, I would assume the bill for the fee would be canceled and the member would then transfer after entering the new society at the lower grade?

If new application blanks are not available by January 1, it is assumed that transfers could be sent in on the old application blanks? It is assumed that some body such as the Board of Examiners will remain in existence to process transfers until some replacement committee or board is set up?

Most of these questions involve mechanical operations that are not in themselves too important. These questions are arising, however, and it is believed that it will save a great deal of correspondence if this information can be distributed to our Committee before too many individual problems arise.
