REPORT TO UET

Dear Professor Mulligan:

Recently the Secretaries of the five Founder Societies were requested by the President of United Engineering Trustees to report on the educational activities of their organizations. There was strong inference that, if a significant contribution to education could be demonstrated in the aggregate of these reports, a major Philanthropic Foundation might be interested in granting substantial aid to such educational programs.
