

# Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, June 18-21, 1991

The Fifth Joint Magnetism and Magnetic Materials -INTERMAG Conference will be held at the Pittsburgh Hilton. This meeting combines the Annual Conference on Magnetism and Magnetic materials and the INTERMAG Conference; it will be the only meeting of either of these two major conferences in 1991. The Conference is jointly sponsored by the American Institute of Physics and the Magnetics Society of the IEEE, in cooperation with the American Physical Society, the Office of Naval Research, the Metallurgical Society of the AIME, the American Society for Testing and Materials, and the American Ceramic Society.

Members of the domestic and international science and engineering communities interested in recent developments in magnetism and its associated technologies are invited to attend the Conference and to contribute to the technical sessions. The scope of the Joint Conference embraces all areas of basic science, applied science and engineering in magnetism.
