Dear Dr. Teare:

At Mr. Hibshman's suggestion I am sending you some cards and a copy of an analysis of them keyed to figures and letters appearing in the upper left hand corner of the cards. I have retained, in order to save useless mailing costs, 210 straw-vote (yellow) cards on which voters merely checked "I favor the Merger of AIEE-IRE." All the rest of the cards, both yellow and white (request cards) are being mailed to you with this letter. We do not require their return to Headquarters.

The yellow cards being sent you include:

- 58 cards, identified by categories a-f, inclusive, analyzed in the statistics;
- 10 cards voting against Merger, of which the last two contain comments, identified as category g;
