AIEE STATISTICS

Enclosed are the figures requested this morning. I have added the geographical distribution of members as of August 1, 1961, and a copy of the 1960-1961 Annual Report prepared for the officers and committeemen.

The student count by Districts is a year old. We make this as of November 15 and include just those students actually in college as paid up student members. The "AIEE STUDENT COUNT", also enclosed, shows closely how the gross student membership figure comes about and what it includes at this time of year. Later, in April, the composition of the student member count has changed, but the totals remain around 10,000.

Regular membership takes a sudden drop in June when upward of 2,300 may be dropped for non-payment of dues. So, the August 1 figures are always less than the April 30 figures.
