Dear President Hooven:


At the IRE Executive Committee meeting on last Thursday, we discussed your proposal of a joint membership arrangement between the IRE and the AIEE. It was felt that this was a desirable arrangement and that we would so recommend to the Board of Directors.

Would you care to indicate further as to your thoughts concerning the willingness of the AIEE to join with the IRE in this matter? We have assumed that the wording of a suitable agreement might be identical to that of the agreement between the AIEE and the ASME which you supplied.

If this wording appears satisfactory to the AIEE, we are prepared to recommend it to the Board of Directors at its meeting in Kansas City on November 2.

I am intending to have some exploratory discussions at the ECPD meeting this week concerning IRE affiliation with that organization and with EJC.
