





I have discussed it with Dr. Baker and a few older members around here and I am sure there will be no real opposition.



We beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of May 14th, for which please accept our thanks. We are glad to have the information it contains, in regard to the total membership of your Section, as a matter of record.

The membership of the Schenectady Section, including the local members, by far exceeds that of any other Section. The Chicago Section leads in the number of Institute members. You may be interested in the following figures, which represent the Institute membership in six of the leading Sections:

Chicago	314
Schenectady	219
Philadelphia	173
Pittsburgh	157
Boston	131
San Francisco	115

So far as we know, none of these Sections has a local membership, with the exception of Schenectady and San Francisco. These figures are taken from our record as it stood at the time our 1909 catalogue was issued, and therefore are not quite up to date, but the difference is slight. The average attendance at the meetings

of these Sections for the 11 months ending March 31,
1909, was as follows:

Scherectady	275
Chicago	237
Boston	153
Pittsburgh	133
San Francisco	80
Philadelphia	89

While the Pittsfield Section had, at the time the catalogue was issued, only 44 Institute members, the local membership there has brought the average attendance up to 88. The Ithaca Section might also be mentioned as having fairly good attendances, the average being 114, but as the Institute membership there is only 18, this is due either to local membership or students .
