### ENGINEERS MAP MERGER

#### 2 Big Societies Name Panels to Consider Consolidation

Two big engineering societies, the Institute of Radio Engineers and the American Institute of Electrical Engineers are considering consolidation, it was announced yesterday.

The two organizations have a total membership of more than 150,000 engineers, scientists, educators and industrialists. The boards of directors of both have set up a joint committee to study the feasibility of such a move and the form such consolidation would take.

The committee includes the president of both societies, Lloyd V. Berkner for the radio engineers and Warren H. Chase for the electrical engineers.
