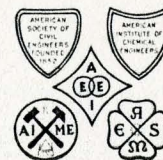

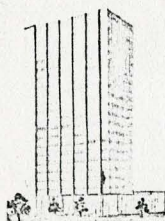
Dear Mr. Hibshman:

You asked for UET's position regarding the Library assessment as it may pertain to the proposed AIEE-IRE merger.

The UET Board of Trustees have not taken an official position on this matter. However, in conversation with Mr. Fairman, UET President, and Mr. Fletcher, Past President and Chairman of the Real Estate Committee, it is the intent to maintain the Library budget at its current level (barring unforeseen eventualities) for the October 1, 1962 - September 30, 1963 fiscal year. On this basis, with equal participation by the merged Society, the Library assessment for the IEEE, based on a membership of 129,000, would approximate 40¢ per member.
