It gives me pleasure to inform you of the very successful first meeting of the IEEE Section "Ukraine" which took place in Kyiv in the evening of Monday, November 4th, 1991. The meeting was held on the premises of the Kyiv Polytechnic Institute and was chaired by its Rector, Professor P.M. Talanchuk, the pro-tem Chairman of the Section. In attendance were about 40 persons, mostly newly accepted members of IEEE from Kyiv, although a few IEEE members from other cities in Ukraine, notably, Lviv, Luhansk, Kharkiv and Odessa, as well as a few non-members, were present.

United Contractions of Societions

The agenda of the meeting included my talk on the "Aims and Structure of IEEE", a presentation entitled "Canadian Universities and the Engineering Profession in Canada" by Professor G.W. Heinke, Dean of Applied Science and Engineering at the University of Toronto, and a discussion on the "Ontario Provincial Centres of Excellence" by Professor G.R. Purdy, Dean of Engineering from the McMaster University. In my presentation I have extended to the Section greetings from you as the Vice President in charge of IEEE Regional Activities. I expect Minutes of the Meeting will be issued and forwarded to yourself or Mel Olken.

On the basis of the enthusiasm existing at the meeting and in Ukraine in general, I expect the Section to show a great deal of activity. I mentioned to them the Regional Meeting in Lausanne, Switzerland early next year and they are planning to send a representative. In parallel, they will be working during the next year on electing a permanent Executive of the Section.

Subject: Possible Section Formation in the Ukraine Republic

Today I met with Boris Mokin, who visited me in my office at McMaster University. In addition to some discussion about our common interest in the field of "power engineering", we discussed matters of interest to IEEE.

A friend of his, Prof. Wynnycki, Chem. Eng., Univ. of Waterloo, accompanied him and acted as translator.

Prof. Mokin is an electrical power engineer, and a member of the Ukraine parliament in addition to his duties as President of the Polytechnic.

He wishes to become a member of IEEE, assist others in the Ukraine to become members, and then to form an IEEE section that is independent of the Moscow Section and encompases the Republic of the Ukraine.

He believes there are hundreds of engineers in the Ukraine who could qualify to become IEEE members. He notes that while there is an umbrella organization for technical interests, electrical engineers are separated into speciality groups with little or no interaction. We discussed the concept that the formation of a Section with Chapters in several key speciality areas could be very beneficial locally as it might be an effective co-ordinating body.

I explained that with the 50% dues reduction policy (related to income level), that a typical membership cost was in the order of \$50 US. He indicated a problem of currency convertability. His comments supported the experience we have gained in our discussions with members in other countries. He seemed to find comfort in the notion that IEEE is an Institute of members (not governments or corporations) but that employers could pay for membership fees on behalf of the member.

We discussed the sequence that:

- (1) first qualified people become members
- (2) a group of 50+ members can request the formation of a Section
- (3) the Section can organize Chapters
- (4) Sections and Chapters can run technical events such as conferences which can generate local income that can be used to counter some of the currency convertability difficulties.


This sequence (etc) along with suitable material describing IEEE, its Societies, and procedures for establishing local units should be sent to Prof. Mokin as soon as possible. We should also advise him of other persons who have expresses similar Onterest. ρ_0/ρ

If he is successful in generating sufficient members and submitting a Section formation petition, I recommend we arrange with existing Sections to change appropriate bylaws regarding territorial boundaries.

I understand that Prof. Mokin is interested in attending the next Region 8 meeting that is being planned (I believe) for Moscow. It would be helpful to put him in contact with both Region 8 and Poland Section people. To this end, I will provide Sven and Andre with copies of this message. I sense that in all cases regarding possible Sections in various Republics in the U.S.S.R. that it is appropriate to deal directly with individuals in each Republic on a case by case basis.



I believe this to be important as the customary sequence is different (in addition to the difficulties in translating from/to the cyrillic alphabet). Because of these language difficulties, I suggest that we craft suitable material for this purpose.
