

The Miniature Power system is modeled after a substation control room and is used for analog training of system operation, including generator operation, relaying, fault isolation, breaker operation, system reconfiguration, and system restoration. The half-day mini-symposium will present recent developments and clinical applications of bioelectromagnetics covering the frequency range from dc over microwaves to the infrared. One session deals with passive and diagnostic applications. Topics include recent work in the areas of electro- and mangetoencephalography, electrocardiography, magnetic resonance imaging, microwave thermography, and optical blood platelet diagnostics. A second session on active interactions and therapeutics covers magnetic separation of blood components, health effects of low-frequency and microwave power, electrosurgery, and hyperthermia.

Over one dozen physicists, engineers, physiologists, and physicians from various biomedical companies and regional academic institutions will give illustrated presentations and be available for discussions and questions. The meeting is intended to stimulate professional interactions between specialists, but it will also have a tutorial component.
