

BYLAWS

Revised July 9, 1966

I. NAME

The name of this organization is "The <u>Sinta Menice Pay</u> Section of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, Inc.", and may from time to time hereinafter be referred to as the "Section".

II. PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY .

The rules contained in Robert's Rules of Order Revised shall govern the Section in all cases to which they are applicable, and in which they are not inconsistent with the Constitution and Bylaws of the Institute, Council, or Section or the special rules of order of the Section.

III. MEETINGS

No fewer than five regular meetings of the Section shall be held during each fiscal year as specified by the Section Executive Committee. All such meetings shall be open to all members of the Council and shall be announced in the Council publication.

IV. QUORUM

At least 10% of the voting members of the Section, but in no case less than 15, shall be present to constitute a quorum at all meetings of the Section called for the transaction of business and requiring a vote to be taken. A quorum at any committee meeting shall be a simple majority of the members thereof.

V. MANAGEMENT

The Executive Committee of the Section shall meet at least four times yearly and shall be responsible for the operation of the Section. A quorum of the Executive Committee for the transaction of business shall be at least a simple majority of the voting members thereof.

- The Executive Committee shall consist of at least: Α.
 - 1. The following Section officers:
 - (a) Chairman
 - (b) Vice-Chairman
 - (c) Secretary (or Secretary-Treasurer)
 - (d) Treasurer (if a separate officer)
 - 2. Junior Past Chairman
 - 3. Chairmen of the following standing committees:
 - (a) Student Activities
 - (b) Membership
 - (c) Meetings (d) Awards
- B. The Chairman may appoint, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the above members of the Section Executive Committee, additional members to the Section Executive Committee from the Section membership.

VI. STANDING COMMITTEES

The Section Chairman shall, as soon as practicable after his election, appoint the Chairmen of the following Standing Committees:

- 1. Student Activities
- 2. Membership
- Meetings (may be Vice-Chairman)
 Awards
- A. Student Activities: The Student Activities Committee shall consist of a Chairman and Vice-Chairman appointed by the Section Chairman; the Junior Past Chairman of this Committee; and such other members as may be appointed by the Chairman of this Committee. The Chairman of this Committee shall be the Section Student Branch Coordinator and shall represent the Student Branches on the Section Executive Committee.

It shall be the responsibility of this Committee to provide programs to develop student interest and activity, to assist in formation of new Student Branches, to coordinate Student Branch efforts and provide liaison between the Student Branches, the Section, and industry.

B. Membership Committee: The Membership Committee shall consist of a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman appointed by the Section Chairman; and such additional members as may be appointed by the Chairman of this Committee.

The responsibility of this Committee shall be to solicit new members, to encourage the advancement of all members to the highest grade for which they are eligible and to encourage participation of the membership in Section, Council, and Group Chapter activities.

- C. The Meetings Committee shall consist of a Chairman (who may be the Section Vice-Chairman) appointed by the Section Chairman and at least three members appointed by the Chairman of this Committee. The Committee Chairman shall select a Vice-Chairman from among the members of this Committee. This Committee shall have the responsibility for programs to be presented at Section meetings, for associated publicity, for the provision of a meeting place and all necessary and reasonable equipment to conduct Section meetings and social affairs, and for coordinating programs to be presented in conjunction with other organizations.
- D. Awards: The Awards Committee shall consist of a Chairman, appointed by the Section Chairman, with the approval of the Executive Committee, and not less than three, nor more than five additional members appointed by the Chairman of the Awards Committee, with the approval of the Executive Committee. The Chairman of the Awards Committee should, where possible, be a Fellow of the I.E.E.E. and a member of the Section; when a Fellow is not available, then the Chairman should be a Senior Member, I.E.E.E. The remaining members of the Committee shall be members of the Section. One member of the Awards Committee shall have served as a member of the Awards Committee for the immediate past year. The members of this Committee shall select a vice chairman from among their number, who shall act in the absence of the Chairman.

The responsibility of this Committee shall be the selection of candidates from the Section membership for the National awards, for the recommendation for Fellow, for the Regional awards, and for the Council awards. Normally, candidates for the National and Regional awards and Fellow recommendations shall be sent to the Council for
submission to gain the added strength of area representation. This Committee shall have the further responsibility of delivering to the Section Chairman or the succeeding year's officers a record of their work so that there is continuity from year to year.

VII. LADIES AUXILIARY

The wives of the members of the Section may with the approval of the Executive Committee form a Ladies Auxiliary to the Section. The primary purpose of the Ladies Auxiliary shall be, when requested by the Section Executive Committee, to assist the Section in carrying out its functions. The Ladies Auxiliary shall be represented on the Executive Committee by by the Section Vice-Chairman.

VIII. NOMINATING COMMITTEE

This Committee shall consist of at least three members appointed by the Section Chairman, with the approval of the Executive Committee, not later than the first day of December of each year. No member of the Nominating Committee shall be a Section Officer at the time of his appointment. The Section Chairman shall appoint one of the members of this Committee as Chairman thereof. Nonvouse THE SECTION OF THE CONTRACT BE CONTRACT OF SECTION OF THE CONTRACT OF AS FIRITIES OF SECTION The Nominating Committee shall report in the February issue of the Council Publication a selection of at least one candidate for each Section office. Additional nominations by petition may be submitted no later than the first day of April to the Section Executive Committee for inclusion on

the ballot. To be valid, such petitions shall carry the signatures of no fewer than 15 voting members of the Section and include a statement of the willingness of the candidate to serve.

IX. ELECTIONS

CHOSEN FROM -

Elections of officers shall be by letter ballot of Section members with a plurality of votes cast being sufficient for election. Results of the letter ballot shall be announced to the members in the June issue of the Council Publication. The terms of office for all officers shall begin on the first day of July and end on the thirtieth day of June of each year.

X. FINANCE

- A. Income: The primary source of Section income shall consist of those funds transferred to it by the Council in accordance with the budgeting procedures outlined hereunder and in the Council Bylaws.
- B. Bonding: The Section Treasurer and the Section Chairman shall be bonded at Council expense in an amount determined by the Council Committee.
- C. <u>Fiscal Year</u>: The fiscal year of the Section shall be the calendar year.
- D. Audit: The Council Committee shall arrange for an audit, by an independent auditing firm, of the books of the Section Treasurer at the end of each fiscal year.
- E. <u>Finance Committee</u>: The Finance Committee shall consist of the Section Treasurer, who shall be Chairman; the Section Junior Past Chairman; and the Chairman of the Meetings Committee.






