## The Establishment of the Geneva Section approved

The Executive Committee of the Institute of Radio Engineers, at its meeting on 13 December, 1960, approved the establishment of a Geneva Section of the Institute. The consideration was the result of the interest of members in Switzerland in having section activities and meetings, so they could gather together to hear interesting talks on new technical developments and to exchange views on development in the field of radio engineering. A group of Members, Professor Tank of Zurich, Dr. Gerber of Berne, Jean Lebel of Vaud and John Gayer of Geneva, have exchanged views among themselves and other Members for some time on how such a section in Switzerland should be organized.

The recent visit of the 1960 President of the I.R.E., Dr. Ronald MacFarlan, brought out the wide interest in Institute activities by the members residing in Switzerland. After hearing his message on the development of the Institute and the interest of the Institute in international symposiums and the world-wide exchange of technical information, those of us who had the opportunity to visit with him and discuss the possibilities of organizing a section in Switzerland, were convinced that now was the opportune time to organize the Geneva Section.

The Executive Secretary of the Institute, Dr. George W. Bailey, sends us the Institute's best wishes for the great success of the newest section and advises the section that the Board of Directors of the National Headquarters are constantly seeking ways and means of improving their services to members. The Headquarters would greatly appreciate it if we would contact them on any problems encountered. The Benelux Section of I.R.E. sends us their best greetings for the new I.R.E. Section in Geneva. The President, Ir. H. Rinia and the Secretary, Bruce Barrow, plan on attending our inaugural meeting and stand ready to further assist us.

#### Organization of the Geneva Section

It is now for us to arrange for the first meeting of this Section and to organize the operation of the Geneva Section. At the first meeting. officers must be elected and a programme for the year approved. The officers and chairmen of committees for a section are normally at least:

> President Vice President Secretary Treasurer Chairman of Membership Committee Chairman of Program Committee Publicity Chairman (and Editor)

It is suggested that Members should consider whom they wish to have for officers for the year 1961.

## Program for 1961

Proposed for the first year's program is to have four meetings in Geneva and an inspection trip of wide interest to all Members. Along these lines there could be a meeting in February, April, September and November.

The inaugural meeting will be held on Monday evening 27th February at 6.30 p.m., commencing with a dinner in the Palais des Nations Restaurant, Geneva, when we shall have the pleasure of an address by Dr. F. L. Stumpers, of Philips Research Laboratories, on "Stereophonic broadcasting systems for the FM band, with special reference to a controlled subcarrier FM-AM-system". Further details on the meeting and the programme will be sent to you separately.

### National U.R.S.I. Meeting in Berne

Members certainly appreciated the thoughtfulness of the Swiss National Committee of U.R.S.I. of inviting I.R.E. Members to attend the U.R.S.I. meeting held in Berne on 25th November. Those of us who could attend, found the meeting most interesting, and greatly appreciated the opportunity of getting together with the U.R.S.I. members.

## I.R.E. Members in Switzerland

I.R.E. Headquarters sent us a list of I.R.E. Members residing in Switzerland. This list is being reproduced and will be sent to all members. It is interesting to note the number of I.R.E. Members in Switzerland and their wide professional interests. There has been considerable interest expressed in I.R.E. activities which leads one to believe that an additional number of other radio engineers will join the Institute now that sectional activities are being organized, which leaves an interesting and challenging opportunity for the Membership Committee.

Dear Mr. Gayer:

I wish to acknowledge and thank you for your letter of February 21, 1957. In response to your request, I am enclosing some material describing the requirements for Section formation and also a current list of IRE members in Switzerland. This has been compiled by Miss Emily Sirjane at IRE Headquarters with whom you may communicate directly on future matters concerned with the formation of your proposed Section.

As you will note the present requirements for a Section petition stipulate that it must be signed by at least twenty-five IRE members of Associate grade or higher. I see from our membership list that you have eleven members in Geneva and thirty in Zurich, so I presume that if you wish to do so and if the members are agreeable, you would be able to obtain the signatures of twenty-five members to form a Section whose territory would logically be Switzerland and whose name should be determined by the petitioners.

Your proposal to work closely with Professor Tank is a very happy one since he was Vice President of IRE in 1955.

For your further information, we now have under discussion a proposal to change our rules for new Sections to be formed outside Continental North America whereby a minimum of ten rather than twenty-five signatures would be required on the Section petition. This will come before the Board of Directors for the final decision at a meeting on April 11, and although I believe that the Board will act affirmatively, I have of course no way of guaranteeing this in advance.

One other point that occurs to me is that should such a Section or Chapter be formed I would think the name European would be inappropriate as it might embarrass future expansion or formation of additional Sections and Chapters. As a matter of fact the thought Geneva Section springs naturally to mind and its territorial definition could be made as extensive as circumstances warrant.

# REQUIREMENTS TO FORM A CHAPTER OF AN IEEE SOCIETY

A Chapter is a technical subunit of one or more Sections, or a Council, constituted by a minimum of twelve (12) members of a Society and established by petition to the parent unit(s) and Societies concerned to represent and fulfill the needs of the members and the missions of IEEE. A Chapter functions in a manner similar to that of a committee of the Section. In instances where Section territorial geography may warrant and Society member interests are sufficient to support multiple Chapters of a Society, additional Chapters, suitably identified, may be formed and operate under the current applicable procedures. (IEEE Bylaw 406.1).

A petition, signed by not less than twelve (12) Section members, above Student grade, who are members of the Society shall be submitted to the Section Executive Committee, via the Section Secretary, for approval. It is suggested that more than the specified amount of names and signatures be included to assure that all petitioners qualify, thus speeding the processing of the petition.

The petition shall specify:

- The name of the Section
- The name of the Society
- The name and address of the Chapter organizer

With the written approval of the Section Executive Committee, the petition shall be mailed to:



Regional Activities staff will review the petition and work with the organizer to resolve any discrepancies. The Chapter shall be considered established after Regional Activities has ascertained that the Regional Director and the Society President(s) have no objections to the formation of the Chapter.

Following approval, the Section Chairman, the Chapter Organizer, the Regional Director and the President of the Society will be notified. The Chapter formation will be noted in the Report of the Staff Director at the next meeting of the Regional Acitivites Board.

## TO FORM A JOINT CHAPTER COVERING TWO OR MORE SOCIETIES

The requirements are the same as for a single Society Chapter, with the following exception. Of the 12 signatures on the petition, not less than three shall be members of each of the Societies involved.

For example, a joint Microwave Theory & Techniques (MTT-17) and Antennas & Propagation (AP-03) Society Chapters might be formed with eight petitioners belonging to MTT-17 and four petitioners to AP-03. It is not required, though it may be useful, that Chapter members or officers maintain membership in both Societies. It is suggested that more than the specified amount of names and signatures be included to assure that all petitioners qualify, thus speeding the processing of the petition.

# TO FORM A JOINT CHAPTER COVERING TWO OR MORE CONTIGUOUS SECTIONS

A petition must be signed by not less than twelve (12) members, other than Students, of the Sections involved, who are members of the Society or Societies, and submitted for approval by the pertinent Sections Executive Committees. It is suggested that more than the specified amount of names and signatures be included to assure that all petitioners qualify, thus speeding the processing of the petition.

The petition shall specify:

- The names of the Sections involved
- The name(s) of the Society or Societies
- The name and address of the Chapter Organizer
- The organizational unit (administrative parent Section) which shall be responsible for the Chapter management. In joint Chapters, administrative matters relate to the parent Section.

With the written approval of the entities involved, the petition shall be mailed to:



The Joint Chapter shall be considered established after Regional Activities has ascertained that all entities involved have no objections to the formation of Chapter.

Following approval, the Sections and Societies involved, the Chapter organizer and the Regional Director will be notified. The Chapter formation will be noted in the Report of the Staff Director at the next meeting of the Regional Activities Board.


